INDIANAPOLIS - Foamcraft's factory-direct mattress brand, Comfort Option, launched its first true retail location on May 1 in a prominent location within Circle Centre Mall in downtown Indianapolis.

The most intersting part about this news is that during the entire month of May, the brand didn't have to pay a dime for rent.

An Indianapolis group called Develop Indy launched an initiative called StartUp 317, which pairs small companies with limited budgets to landlords needing to fill retail spaces. The goal is to provide applicants a chance to test the retail waters free of charge, with the hopes of placing long term tennants in stores that would otherwise sit vacant.

The program is a win-win for everyone involved, and it's an opportunity that Comfort Option is extremely thankful to have been included in.

Retail storefronts aren't foreign in Foamcraft's long history. Through the years, multiple stores have carried the Foamcraft name. However, as real estate costs have risen and its direct to consumer business faded, decades passed

by without any real activity in the retail business.

The partnership with StartUp 317 has provided a unique opportunity for Foamcraft's growing brands, especially Comfort Option and Foamnasium, to get back into brick and mortar stores.

CRAFTSMANSHIP SPOTLIGHT: Rick Annes

GREENFIELD - There are some people who's lives tell amazing stories. Rick Annes is a person like that.

Coming to Foamcraft through a temp agency in the winter of 2016, it was quickly evident that his skillset as a mechanic and trainer could be utilized in deeper ways. As a result, the Plant Manager of Greenfield at the time, Bob Ivers, took full advantage.

However, June 15 of 2018 could have changed all of that. Rick was involved in brutal crash on his motorcycle, an accident that left him with a crushed pelvis, a zshattered leg, three broken ribs, a punctured lung, and a diagnosis from doctors that he wouldn't walk again for at least 6 months.

Rick was back walking up stairs in Greenfield in less than 4. He had no plans to sit and wait. In fact, he had already bought a new motorcycle even before he was out of a wheelchair.

He credits a will to work for his speedy recovery. "Once I got out of the wheelchair, I never went back. Once I got off the walker I never went back." Rick said.

He gives great credit to some the Foamcraft family for support during that season, especially Bob Ivers and Rob Elliott.

"Before I was out of the wheelchair, Rob called me at home and



told me he wanted me to come back, at least for part-time work," Rick remembers. "How many companies would have done that?" Rick only had one comment when asked what he thought Foamcraft could do better. "I guess pay me more money," he said. He quickly clarified, "Just me, though."
